About



StatiX is a Kontakt instrument library.

It emulates noise of the vinyl.

It has 33 samples 16 bit sample rate 44100.

It's a small size library only 9,35 MB

StatiX II is an update of StatiX.

Installation

Decompress downloaded ZIP file at your want directory.

Please keep a copy for your original ZIP file.

This library doesn't require any special activation.

Folders

Documentation : There is a User Manual

Instruments : There is one NKI file.

Samples : There are 33 .WAV files for .NKI preset.

Loading

Preset will be loaded by double click .NKI files or drag into Kontakt. Or you can load by click Files button on Main Control Panel of Kontakt.

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What is New



At the old version of StatiX
we have 20 notes.

Each note was a different preset
(when the presets knob is up to 0).



The new version of StatiX has only one note and you can choose your one of 20 presets by the arrows left and right of the main display. We add a new Reset button to initialize the instrument. Also we add a new layout .

Instrument Details

StatiX II has seven knobs two buttons and one value display.



Knobs

Presets knob Adjusts volume on Presets channel.

Dust knob Adjusts volume on Dust channel.
Determines how many dust want to your vinyl.

Electric knob Adjusts volume on Electric channel.
Determines how many electric shock
noise want to your vinyl.

Motor knob Adjusts volume on Motor channel.
Determines how many mechanical
motor noise want to your vinyl.

Scratch and Number knobs Those two are combined knobs

The first one adjusts volume on Scratch channel.
Determines how many mechanical motor noise want to your vinyl.

The second one determines how many scratches want to your vinyl. 0 up to 10.

Vinyl type knob Select the type and the age of the vinyl.

Presets Arrows If you don't like to adjust knobs press Reset Button and choose one of the 20 presets by adding or subtracting from the arrows.

Randomize Button If you hate to adjust knobs press Randomize Button maybe one sound fits on you.

Reset Button This button reset the settings in its initial mode.

Value Display This little screen allows you to see the settings with great detail and accuracy.
