The Rathgar Pipe Organ

The Rathgar Pipe Organ sample library is created with samples carefully recorded from the pipe organ from the Christ Church Rathgar, in Dublin – Ireland. The samples were recorded with 2 stereo pairs of microphones, in December of 2020.

This organ is over a hundred years old, was first built in 1899, and has a unique sound full of character. The intent of the library is to preserve the authentic sound of this beautiful instrument and capture with detail all the nuances of the sound of the Pipe Organ in the church hall.

To capture the real sound of the organ and all the acoustic interactions of the sound in the church, we recorded carefully tailored presets with the best combination of stops for this particular instrument.





Overview:

This virtual instrument is a sample library that use Native Instruments KONTAKT sampler. They are not licensed by Native Instruments, **requiring the full version of KONTAKT 5.8** or higher to run. With the free Kontakt player the instruments will only run in demo mode.

Installation:

This sample library does not require installation. However, you need to have the full version of the Kontakt Sampler installed in your computer in order to run the **nki** files. As this library is not licensed by Native Instruments they do not require serial number or installation via Native Access.

After downloading and unpacking the zip file containing the library you can run the nki files directly with Kontakt Sampler. If you double-click the nki files a standalone instance of Kontakt will open with the instrument loaded.

You can also simply drag and drop the nki file into an instance of Kontakt, standalone or within your DAW.

Another way to load your instruments is from the "Files" tab within Kontakt, located next to the "Libraries" tab on the upper left side of the Kontakt interface. Note that as these instruments are not licensed by Native Instruments they will not show under the "Libraries" tab.

Using Quickload

For quicker access of the instruments within Kontakt, you can add them to your Quickload menu. To do this, go to the Workspace Management menu (third icon on the top right) and click on Quickload (or cmd+F). This will open up the Quickload menu on the bottom of the Kontakt interface. Now you can simply drag and drop your nki files into your Quickload menu.



About The Rathgar Pipe Organ

The Rathgar Pipe Organ sample library comes with 22 different instruments, each containing its own nki file. 12 nki with the authentic natural organ sound, and 10 more presets within the Creations folder, with more processed creative sounds built from the natural organic presets.

The library offers 2 microphones positions – close and far – and various built-in controls and effects distributed in 2 user interface windows.
