INTRODUCTION

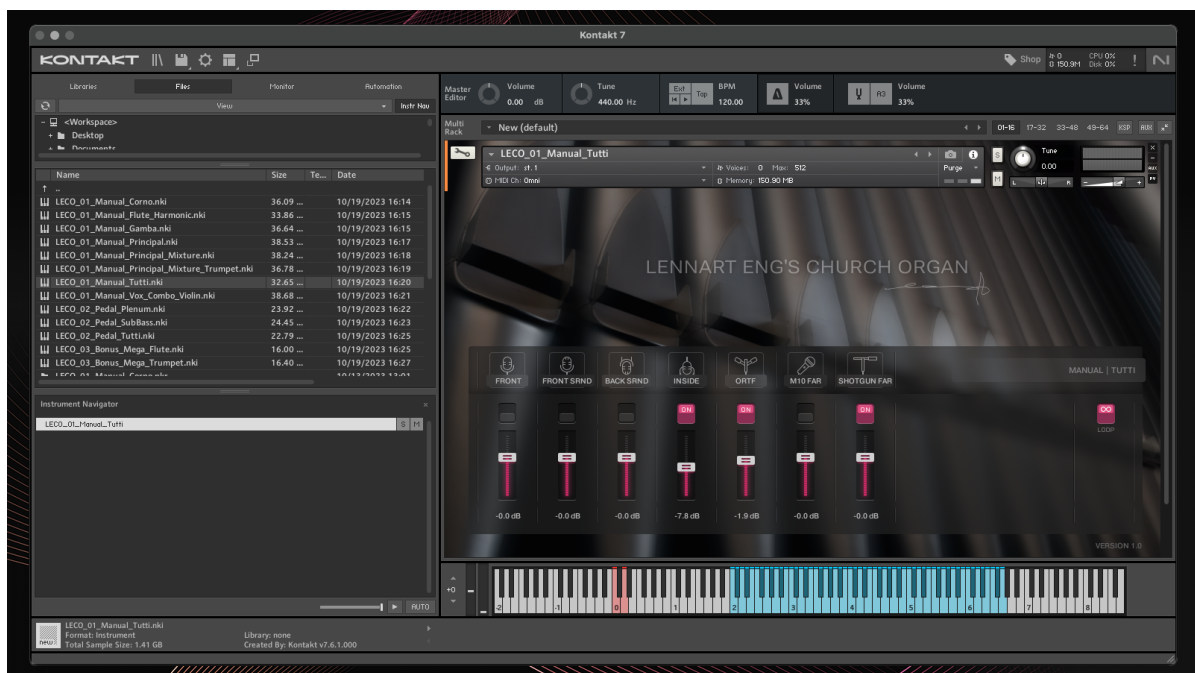
Lennart Eng's Church Organ is a deep-sampled Swedish pipe organ. It first appeared in the video game It Takes Two where it played a big role in the music level. This instrument was originally constructed and released for the Elias Sampler but is now reworked and for the first time released for the Native Instruments Kontakt 7 sampler. If you are interested in using this live in a game, please contact the team at Elias about the Elias Sampler version.

LENNART ENG

Lennart Eng (born 1945) was an Organist and pianist from Färila up north in Sweden. Apart from being the Organist, choir director, etc. in Färila församling, he was also the concert pianist in the Swedish Jussi Björling society. He had a long career as a record producer with over 70 albums. The things Lennart Eng didn't know about pipe organs weren't worth knowing. His impact on this recording with all the registers and know-how about perfect spots for mic positions, was crucial for making this organ library.

PIPE ORGAN STOPS

Each pipe organ stop is an individual .nki file. These can be played by themselves or loaded in the same session and played together. Just load the instruments under the Files tab in Kontakt 7 and locate the folder where you unpacked the files.

- Long * DESIGNED TO LOOP
- Staccato * LONG OR STACCATO IS SET VIA THE LOOP BUTTON FOR EACH STOP

- Close Front
- Inside Close
- M10 Stereo Far
- ORTF Close
- Shotgun Far
- Close Back Surround
- Close Front Surround
