

Falcon Air EQ - User Manual by Safari Pedals

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1. Introduction

The Falcon Air EQ — your new secret weapon for taming harsh sibilance and dialing in that perfect, airy shimmer.

Equal parts de-esser and high-frequency enhancer, Falcon Air EQ gives you everything you need to soften the sting and lift your mix into the stratosphere.

Whether you're wrangling a brittle overhead or giving a dull mix that final breath of life, Falcon Air EQ flies in with surgical precision and sweet musicality.



2. Installation

Installation For Mac users:

The included installer should install the plugin's VST3, AU, and AAX formats automatically, you may need to restart your DAW to see the plugin listed.

For Windows users:

You will have to manually move the plugin formats into their respective folders. Common locations for each format are as follows:

- VST3: C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3
- AAX: C:\Program Files\Common Files\Avid\Audio\Plug-Ins

If after restarting your DAW, you still don't see the plugin listed, check your DAW's plugin folder settings, and be sure that the plugin is in the proper location for your software.

3. Product registration

When launching the Falcon Air EQ for the first time, you will see the serial registration screen, and if you have not yet purchased a license, here is where you can begin your trial period. If purchased, enter your license key for the product and click the submit button to start getting wild

During trial mode you can still register at any time by clicking the serial number prompt, and opening the registration prompt from there. After your trial ends you will go back to seeing the registration prompt every time you open an instance, and you will have to register the product to continue.

4. Features

Remember: Double clicking + pressing command will restore the default settings of any selected knob

Frequency: Choose the exact area to enhance or tame



Air Gain: Boost or cut the level of the frequency you picked



Air Drive: A touch of saturation to sweeten the highs



4. Features

Input / Output Gain: Set your level before and after the magic

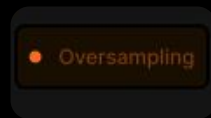


De-esser Amount: Set how much de-essing you want to remove harshness



4. Features

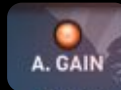
Over-Sampling: Avoid aliasing and maintain pristine audio quality.



Blend: Mix the raw and fully taped signal to find the perfect balance.



Auto Gain: Keeps levels even as you crank the input / output knob.
