

Hippie Elephant – User Manual

Granular Reverb

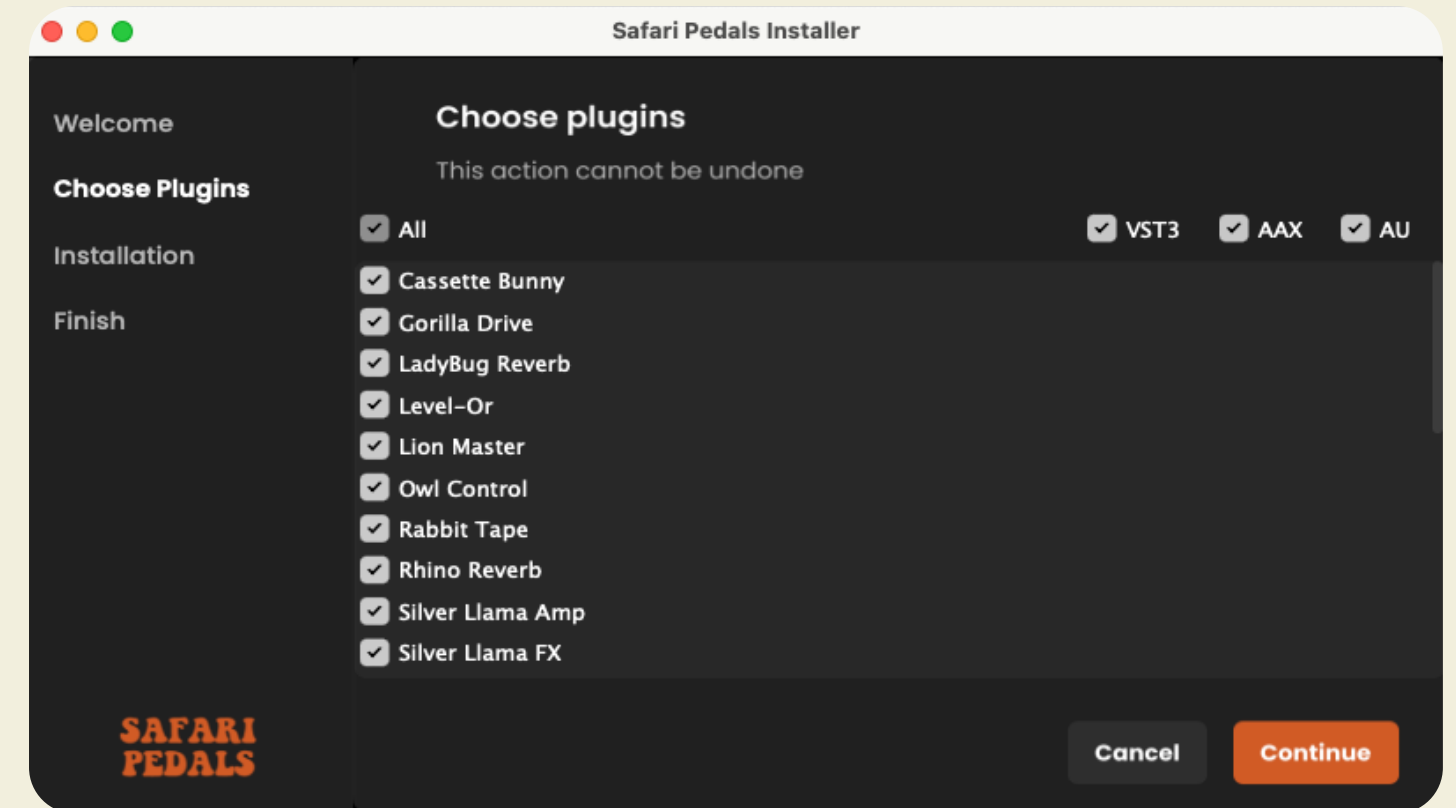
Hippie Elephant is our dreamy, warbly granular reverb a swirling cloud machine that freezes, shimmers, and melts your audio into psychedelic textures. Shape the grain size with **TIME**, bend the space with **PITCH**, darken/brighten with **TONE**, and ride a built-in **TREMOLO** for hypnotic movement. It's instant vintage-sci-fi ambience for guitars, vocals, synths, and beyond.



Installation

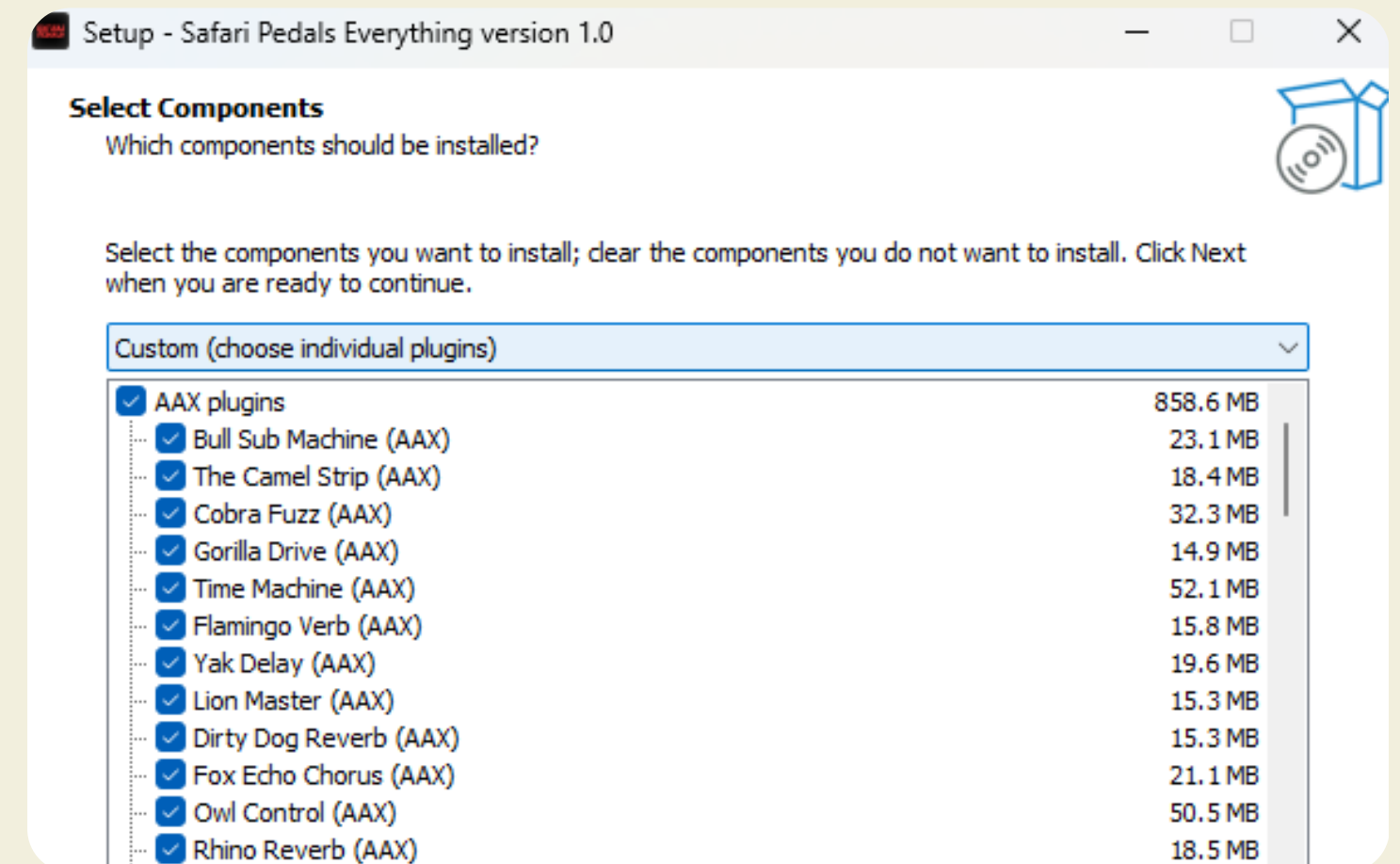
For Mac users:

- Open the .pkg installer.
- Accept the license agreement.
- Choose the Safari Pedals plugins you want and the format (VST3, AU and/or AAX).
- Click Continue, enter your password and install.



For Windows users:

- Open the .exe installer.
- Accept the license agreement.
- Choose the Safari Pedals plugins you want and the format (VST3 and/or AAX).
- Click Next → Install.

Launch the Plugin

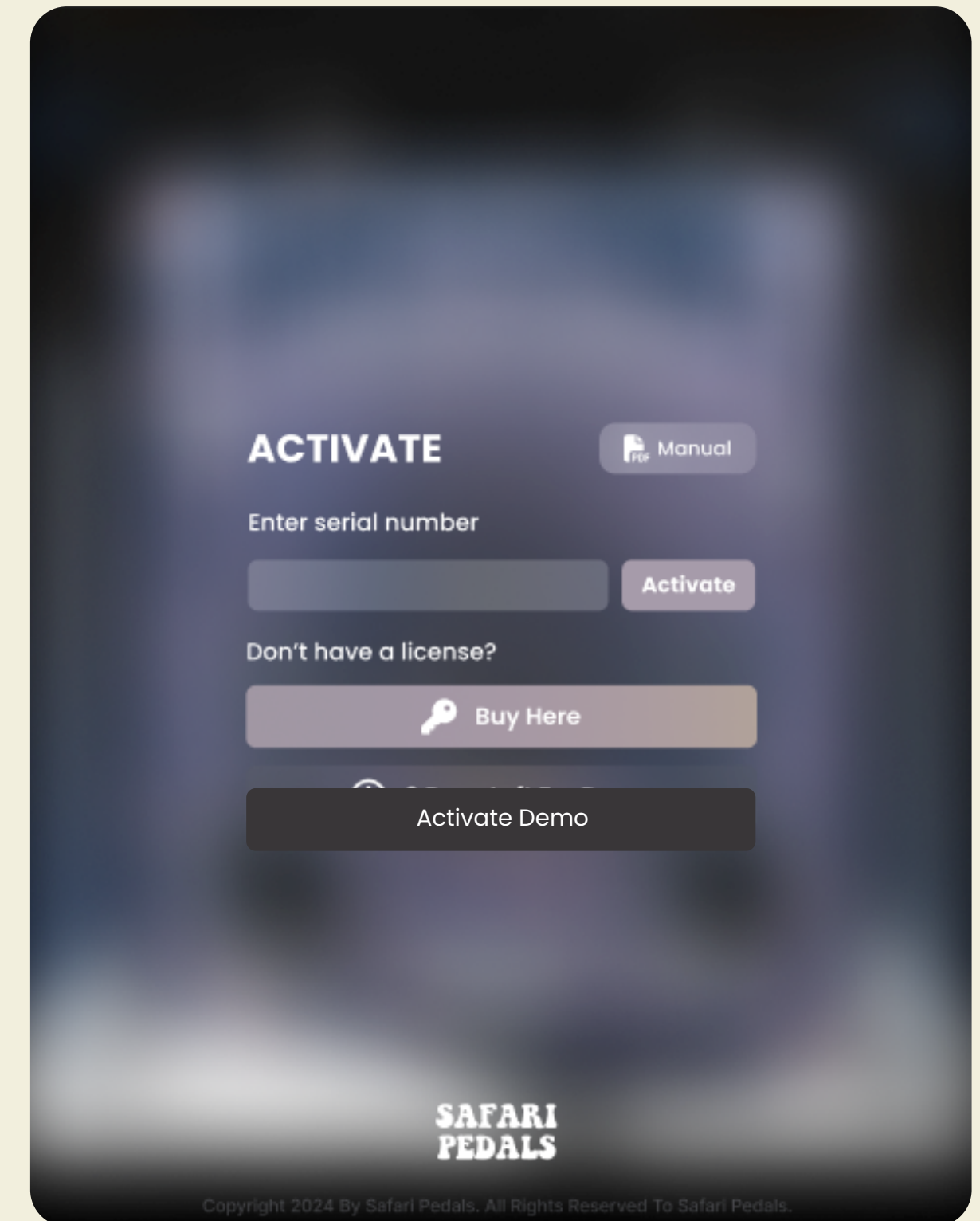
When you open the plugin for the first time, you'll see the registration screen.

License Types – Subscription VS Perpetual :

- A Subscription includes all current and future plugins. Once activated, any new plugin you download will work without requiring additional authorization.
- A Perpetual License gives you lifetime access to the plugins you purchased, but it does not include future plugin releases.

Offline Use

An internet connection is required only for the first activation. After that, the plugin will continue to work offline without needing to reauthorize.

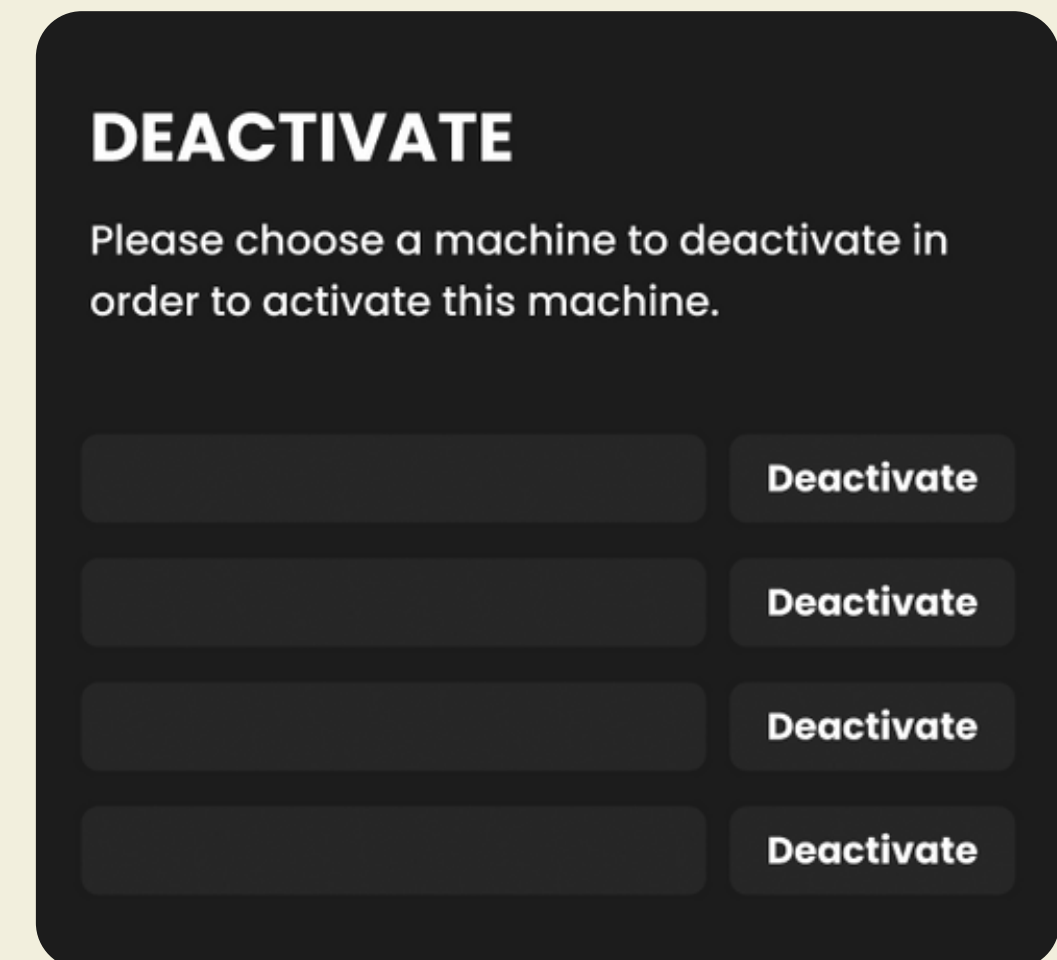
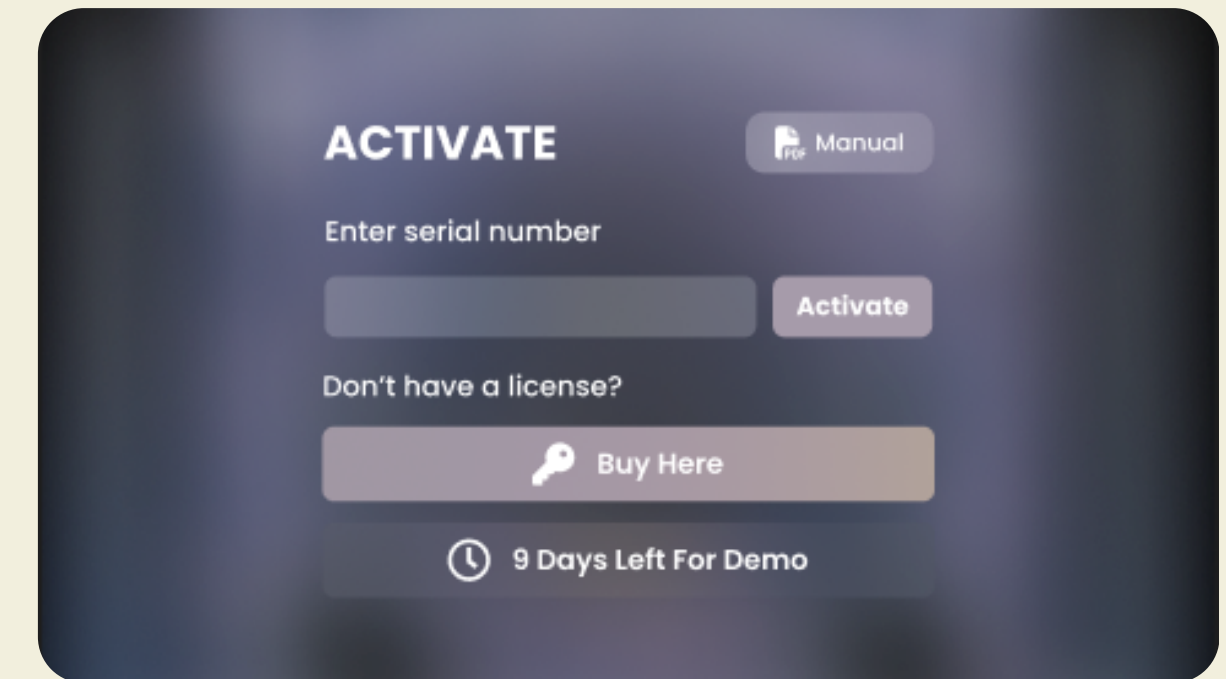
Start a Trial or Register

- If you haven't purchased a license yet, Click “Activate Demo” to begin your free evaluation period of 14 days. Once the demo period ends, the plugin interface and processing will be disabled until a valid license is entered.
- If you already have a license key, Enter it and click “Activate” to activate the full version.

Too Many Devices?

If you've reached the limit of 4 devices, you'll need to deactivate one of your previous activations.

You can manage your devices in the registration screen to remove an older device and free up a spot.



Features

- **Tone** – Tilt-style filter to darken for vintage tape-verb vibes or brighten for airy sparkle.
- **Time** – Sets grain/reverb length and density from tight rooms to endless clouds.
- **Pitch** – Shifts the reverb grains for chorus-like detune, shimmer, or deep dive textures.
- **Freeze** – Grabs the current tail and holds it as an infinite texture; play over it or reshape it live.



Features

Tremolo Section – Built-in movement for the wet signal:

- **Amount** – Depth of the tremolo applied within the reverb tail.
- **Speed** – Rate from slow pulses to rapid flutter.



Features

- **IN / OUT Sliders** – Fast gain staging on the sides for clean or driven ambience.
- **Blend** - Controls the mix between the wet signal and the original dry signal.
- **Auto Gain** - Keeps levels even as you crank the input / output knob.



Troubleshooting

If something isn't working as expected, don't worry — most issues are quick to resolve.

Be sure to re-read through the Setup section of this manual just in case something was missed during installation or activation.

Double-check your DAW settings, plugin folder paths, and system compatibility.
